JULY 16th, 2017

In my semi-active retirement, which finds me helping out at a combined parish of two churches, in the southern part of the “Garden State”, I meet a sampling of authentic farmers. Their number steadily dwindles, as suburbia makes its relentless inroads into their territory. They wistfully tell me that this “Bellevue Acres” housing development used to be “Farm W.” Or that “Produce Stand X” did quite a business when it was flourishing, but now it’s gone. Or that “Farm Y” is up for sale to make room for more than a hundred mini-mansions. Ironically, many of those new homeowners will likely decorate their newly sodded lawns with old farm equipment newly-painted to match their shutters.

When such laments run out, I enjoy listening to their stories of raising crops, and the unexpressed pride they have in coaxing good things out of Mother Earth. Or in breeding horses or cows.

The New Testament record tell us Jesus was a carpenter or construction worker but He sure understood farming. He also knew farmers’ lives, perhaps through His interaction with them as customers of His business. Jesus loved their plain stories because he loved people. I’m certain that He smiled at their recall of little victories over capricious weather. So He taught them using those marvelous parables that still intrigue us today.

Believe me, those eternal stories are not easily matched. I used to assign my former high schoolers in my English classes to write an original parable of their own. While I got back clever renditions of Jesus’ originals, none of them ever came up with a truly new parable of their own. Perhaps it was unfair of me to impose that task on them. But together we re-appreciated the mastery of Our Lord.

In using examples His humble audiences would understand, Jesus not only exercised masterful teaching methods, but also a subtle form of mercy. His mission involved the announcement of startling new truths and the arrival of a kingdom of which they had no concept. He led them to understand gradually His earth-shattering “good news.”

We moderns, who only see farms passing by our SUV windows, or on a PBS documentary, nonetheless can make the connection between seed sown and teaching accepted. That’s the mastery of Jesus. Of course our challenge is to be that “rich soil” that made Him smile.

Sacrament of Baptism

Congratulations on the birth of your child. The Sacrament of Baptism is normally administered after the 11:30 AM Mass on Sunday. Pre-Jordan class for the parents is required prior to the scheduling of the Baptism. Parents can attend the class before the baby is born. Pre-Jordan class is held on the second Tuesday of each month at 7:00 PM. Please contact the Parish Office at 610.459.2203 to register for the Pre-Jordan class. To schedule a Baptism, please have already obtained the certificates of eligibility and then contact the Parish Office at least two weeks in advance.

Certificates of Eligibility

Congratulations on being asked to be a sponsor at either a Baptism or a Confirmation. You have been asked to be a witness to, and role model of, your Catholic faith. A sponsor is a Roman Catholic who has received the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation, is an active registered member of his or her parish, at least 16 years of age, and if married is in a Sacramental Marriage. Please contact the Parish Office at 610.459.2203 to request a certificate.

Sacrament of Reconciliation

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is celebrated each Saturday afternoon from 4:30 to 5:00, or by appointment.

Elementary Catholic School Education

For parishioners who are present, active and contributing members, for a **minimum of one year**, SFDS Parish will pay a subsidy of \$1000.00 per student.
